**Celebrating 100 Years of Scouting
100th Anniversary Dinner on Saturday 27 Feb 2010 at 7pm, at the Ballroom,
Level 2 of Suntec Singapore International Convention & Exhibition Centre**

2010 will be a very significant year for Scouting in Singapore. That year marks the anniversary of 100 years since Scouting first came to our shores. For a young nation like Singapore, a centenary is a very rare occasion and calls for great celebration. To commemorate this significant and meaningful occasion, the Singapore Scout Association (SSA) is planning and organising a number of events.

2. To start off the celebrations, the Organising Committee has the honour and privilege of hosting a homecoming dinner open to all Scouts, former Scouts and supporters of Scouting. We are targeting to host 100 tables to mark the centenary. We seek your kind support to make this a memorable event and one that will be etched in the annals of Singapore Scouting.

3. The Centenary Anniversary Dinner will be held on **Saturday, 27 February 2010** at 7.00 pm at the **Ballroom, Level 2 of Suntec Singapore International Convention & Exhibition Centre**. We are greatly privileged that one of Singapore's most prominent Scouts, Senior Minister Goh Chok Tong has kindly agreed to honour the Scouting fraternity by gracing the occasion as principal guest of honour.

4. To cover the cost of the dinner, a charge of \$100 a person (or \$1,000 per table of 10) will be levied. This will cover an 8-course dinner and entertainment. You may wish to note that the corkage charge for the first two bottles of wines or spirits has been waived. Any other contributions above the \$100 cover charge are deeply appreciated.

5. As you are aware, Scouting is built around the Patrol system. As the occasion affords one of the best opportunities to catch up on lost time and to reminisce with old buddies and comrades, guests are strongly encouraged to form their own Patrols in tables of 10. The Organising Committee looks forward to sharing this joyous occasion with you.

6. Please note that the closing date for placing the booking is on or before Thursday 31 December 2009. Subject to availability, early birds will be given first choice of tables once the table lay-out is ready.
