Backwoodsman Cooking

This will be the traditional no-utensils method of outdoor cooking. This competition will take place concurrently with the Orienteering Competition which requires 4 scouts per patrol. The food and items provided are attached. Only fire lighters and seasoning items supply at the camp may be utilised while the presentation of the dishes may be at the patrol discretion. The site for the backwoodsman cooking will be made known later.

ORIENTEERING COMPETITION

4 Scouts per patrol will take part in this 2-hour competition. The patrols will be tested on a list of practical orienteering skills (back bearing, pacing, etc.) located within the vicinity of an undisclosed area.

Scout Quiz Competition

3 Scouts per patrol will answer a written paper consisting of 60 questions. They are to work together as a team in answering the set questions. The questions will be based on Scouting history, Scouting current affairs and Scouting skills.

First Aid

This will take place concurrently with the Quiz competition and involve about 5 Scouts per Patrol. The test will centre around the kind of injuries expected during a camp. The Patrols will have to bring their own first aid kit and any other necessities (ex. Scarf) for the Camp and this competition. Scouts will be asked to demonstrate the appropriate First Aid and evacuation method to use during a given situation.

SONG / SKETCH ITEM

The song/sketch competition has been included as it is an integral part of camping. Each patrol will put up a 5 min presentation during the Campers' Night. The items will be judged at the same time and the best performer from each sub-camp will be invited to perform their items during the Campfire on the 2nd last day.

TELEMATCH / SUB-CAMP CHALLENGE

This will be conducted in between 5 day camp. Patrols will compete in general Scout sport and skills. Sub-camp chief will select scout from various unit to represent their sub-camp to compete with other sub-camp.

Pioneering Project (Fun)

This year the theme for pioneering will be FUN. Think of structure kids will more likely to play. Group will have to provide their own equipment for this competition as staves and ropes will not be provided. Group will be required to build a structure of their own chosen design for the competition but the project must be completed within the allocated time. Each patrol will be designated an area of approximately 5m by 5m at the main field area by means of a draw. Banners, flags can be prepared before the camp for this competition.
